

# Corporate partnership commitments

Firstly, on behalf of the city we want to thank you for joining us on the journey to eradicate period poverty and make Bristol the world's first Period Friendly City.

Your commitment as a corporate sponsor is invaluable to the citizens of the city as you have agreed to lead on establishing and maintaining a donation and distribution network in an area of Bristol.

This document outlines what you have agreed to by signing up as corporate partner and what support we have committed to provide.

#### The commitment from you

By signing up as a corporate partner you agree to:

- 1. Act as a donation point for products and store the donated products.
- 2. Distribute products to specific venues on a regular basis (typically bi-monthly) to ensure there is always a constant supply of products at each collection point.
- 3. Pro-actively encourage donations from employees.
- 4. Promote the Period Friendly Places scheme internally and to external stakeholders.
- 5. Provide regularly feedback on progress, successes and challenges to help us measure success and evaluate changes to improve the scheme.
- 6. Make an annual donation to Period Friendly Places to support the sustainability of the charity and purchase product where voluntary donations are insufficient. We suggest a donation of between £500-1,000 but all contributions are greatly appreciated.

### The commitment from Period Friendly Places

- **1. Donation bin:** we will provide you with a branded donation bin for you to put in a public place in your office so employees and others can contribute period products for distribution.
- 2. Distribution boxes: we will provide you with branded boxes to take to new venues.
- **3. Product:** we will provide you with product every two months so you can distribute these to the community venues, if you are not receiving sufficient donations internally.
- **4. Posters:** we will provide branded posters and other promotional materials for you to display in your office and for you to give to community venues when you take the distribution box out.
- **5. Ongoing support:** we will provide on-going support via check in calls every quarter and you have out contact details for any issues occurring in the meantime.

- **6.** Resources, education and support to become a Period Friendly Workplace: we can tailor this to your needs but we can provide bite-size awareness-raising and training presentations for your team, either to be delivered by your staff or by ours; we also offer talks and resources, including a template menstruation and menopause policy.
- 7. Opportunities to network with other Period Friendly Workplaces.
